
Solid timber core composite door







The doors were tested at the University of Salford's Energy House. This is a typical Salford 1919 terraced house and its construction represents 21% of the UK's current housing stock. The house has been reconstructed in a fully environmentally controllable chamber, in which climatic conditions can be maintained, varied, repeated and patterns monitored. For the test, the inside temperature of the Energy House was 25°C with an exterior temperature of 5°C.

The Stable door is the ideal solution for a back door, yet is the perfect choice for a front door too. You can open the top to bring light into your home while still keeping children in – or animals out!

Apart from the very different look of a Stable door, the opening upper leaf can provide both sight and ventilation, while keeping the lower leaf closed to prevent children or animals leaving the home.

On a pleasant summer's day, one can well imagine the pleasure of looking out of the door and smelling the air while leaning on the rail of the lower leaf, and just passing the time...bliss!

The Stable door we offer is not, as so often is the case, a Cottage door that has been cut to form the upper and lower portions of the Stable door. This is the genuine article: constructed specifically with a mid-rail so that when cut through, it forms two leafs. Each leaf is completely surrounded by a rigid subframe providing stability and security, as well as weather protection.

The hardware that is used has been tested thoroughly for suitability of purpose, such that the locks, rack bolt (that joins the two halves), and rebate forming extrusions and rain deflectors, have been specifically designed.

A variety of colours are available as are glazing options. Something different and a bit special....and worth thinking about.





The Ultimate Collection of composite doors feature high security locks as standard. Providing even our basic specification with a level of security that is insurance approved.

For our Police approved "Secured By Design" specification some upgrades are required:

LAMINATED GLASS

This means that one side of the glass units have two sheets of glass which are bonded together. Any attempt to break in through the glass will be dramatically slowed down.

HINGE BOLTS

Steel bolts protect the hinges from attack. Fixed through the hinges and the door, the bolts locate into steel plates on the frame and are exceptionally strong to resist the most determined attack.

TS007 3* CYLINDERS

Door cylinders have become a focus of attack in recent years and many are vulnerable to numerous methods of attack. Our TS007 3* cylinders resist all known methods of attack and are the highest possible specification. BSI Kitemarked, they are uniquely secure for complete peace of mind.

The mini-blind is enclosed within two panes of glass in an aluminium frame that will never need painting. It is controlled using a metallic tab rather than the traditional cord, so it is completely safe for children. And because the blind and the mechanism are totally enclosed, both are completely protected from damage and dust, making them easy to maintain.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Construction

Every Ultimate Collection GRP composite door is manufactured to the highest of standards to ensure it is strong, durable and secure. The door has a perimeter sub-frame of a solid, water-resistant The door has a perimeter sub-frame of a solid, water-resistant

The door has a perimeter sub-frame of a solid, water-resistant polymer material, which is reinforced with Laminated Veneered Lumber (LVL). A thermoset GRP skin is bonded to this sub-frame and the core of the door is then filled with high density, 100% CFC-free polyurethane foam. Finally, water resistant polymer composite rails protect the core from damage or water absorption


CFC-free polyurethane foam. Finally, water resistant polymer composite rails protect the core from damage or water absorption. The door's core is what makes it so thermally efficient and so good at reducing sound. In fact, as you can see from the images on page 6, it is the most thermally efficient door on the market, increasing your home's energy efficiency and saving you money on your energy bills. Your Ultimate Collection GRP composite door has been designed to be easy to maintain. To keep your door clean, prolong the life of the surface finish and protect your warranty, we recommend you wash it regularly using warm soapy water (washing up liquid is ideal) and a soft, lint-free cloth. If you live in a coastal area, in a heavily industrialised area or near a main road, you may need to clean your door more frequently.

The high impact resistant thermoset GRP skin not only keeps your door looking good, it will not expand and contract laterally so your door will not crack or delaminate. All standard solid colours are pre-pigmented and beautifully through-coloured. All other colours are oversprayed with a durable paint that will not peel or crack.

Technical figures

An Ultimate Collection GRP Composite Door has a wealth of facts and figures that prove its quality. The door:

- achieves BS 6375-1 for weather tightness, air, wind and water
- achieves PAS24 2012 security standard and holds Secured by Design approval when fitted with the SBD upgrades (shown on page 35)
- reduces outdoor noise by an average of 31dB
- achieves Global Warming Potential (GWP) score of less than 5
- achieves Ozone Depletion Potential (ODP) score of zero



 meets UK Building Regulations U value requirements of 1.6W/ m2K (down to 1.0W/m2K on some door styles)

Care and maintenance

It is important that you DO NOT use any of the following on your door:

- abrasive cleaners or scouring pads
- any type of bleach or solvent (e.g. white spirit, methylated spirit, cellulose thinners, acetone or nail varnish remover)
- any type of adhesives or tack for providing temporary protection or fixing of seasonal or other decorations etc
- high pressure or steam cleaners.

It is important, when your door is closed, even when you do not deadlock the door, that you always engage the hook locks, by lifting the handle. This will prevent the door bowing over time, from being closed only on the latch. Failure to do this can invalidate your installers guarantee.
